The Bottom Line

Hereford Sires on Commercial Angus Cows will Increase Your Bottom Line:

- Increased conception rate
- Improved feed efficiency
- Reduced input costs
- Improved average daily gain
- Improved cash flow due to increased calving and replacement options
- Heavier calves at weaning
- Increased carcass weight
- Increased rib eye area
- Improved temperament



The cow-calf producer needs to remember the benefits of a strong cross-breeding program has positive long-term financial benefits for an operation. Vertically coordinated beef marketing operations are particularly going to benefit from heterosis. Efficiencies in the cowherd such as fertility and calving percentage are augmented by efficiencies in the feedlot and increased carcass weight and rib eye area at slaughter.

The benefits of cross breeding have been well documented, and as the cattle-cycle heads downward producers can not afford to ignore genetic programs that offer efficiency and reduce costs of production. The strengths of the Hereford breed complement the strengths of the Angus breed and the profits to a commercial operation can be significant. The Circle A Ranch study conducted by the University of Missouri determined that Hereford bulls on Angus cows would add \$514 net over the cow's lifetime in other words an additional \$51 per cow per year to the Rancher's bottom line.
